Blood clots affect many people and have many different causes. Although they can be life threatening, blood clots can be treated effectively.

The American College of Emergency Physicians (ACEP) and the National Blood Clot Alliance (NBCA) have **created a program designed to help you manage your care, especially in the early stages of your diagnosis. This program consists of several components:**

- A series of text-message reminders to help you remember to fill prescriptions and schedule important follow-up appointments with your doctor.
- A website with educational videos to help you learn more about blood clots, and the important steps you can take with your physician to best manage your care.

We want to learn how patients with DVT diagnosis manage their condition with the aid of text message reminders and educational resources.

We will ask that you read text messages with educational material, reply as appropriate, and watch video links as able. You will receive approximately 20 text messages over the course of six weeks. The text messages will decrease in frequency as the program progresses. Standard text messaging rates may apply.

The records from this program will be kept private. Any reports will have de-identified information which will not make it possible to identify you.

Taking part is voluntary. You may opt out of receiving these text messages at any time.

By texting the number above, you consent to your information being used to evaluate the effectiveness of text message reminders and education videos on treatment adherence and increased knowledge. Your information will not be sold or disclosed to any third party.
